APPENDIX C: ANNUAL CONGRESS FEE DISTRIBUTION

INTRODUCTION

This document is an Appendix to the Protocol of EGEA and consists of the detailed information on how to create Annual Congress fee groups as well as how to calculate the Annual Congress fee.

PART I: ANNUAL CONGRESS FEE GROUP BORDERS

Base Year 2013:

Border between Group A & B: 35'000 USD

Border between Group B & C: 25'000 USD

Border between Group C & D: 15'000 USD

These values increase every year by 3.5% in order to reflect the annual average growth in GDP per capita based on purchasing-power-parity.

Variable: Gross domestic product based on purchasing-power-parity (PPP) per capita GDP, current international dollar

The data shall be for the respective year (including IMF staff estimates), reviewed and published by the Event and PR Advisor until the beginning of the registration period for the Annual Congress.

PART II: ANNUAL CONGRESS FEE BY GROUP

The Annual Congress fee is a maximum fee and has a yearly inflation compensation of 2%. The base year 2013 = 157 EUR.

The fees for the different fee groups are adapted according to the following table:

Group A: 100%

Group B: 80%

Group C: 65%

Group D: 50%
