Motivation to apply

Fun fact: Although I have hosted for various exchanges, due to various reasons I have never been to the re-exchange. Luckily, many EGEAns have hosted me on other occasions <3.

Your relevant skills and competence

The first skill I would like to point out is a technical one: I have codesigned (together with among others Rhune van Cleemput) our current official documents. One of the Advisory Board's tasks is to advice on the official procedures of EGEA. Together with my experience and the fact that I have written large pieces of the official documents, I feel competent to advice the current board on these procedures.

On the soft skill side, I'm a communicative person with a critical attitude. Especially EGEA helped me grow my communication skills and how to apply them in an intercultural context. For my master thesis and my work, I gained experience in communicating easy, understandable and straightforward. I'm also not afraid to discuss sensitive topics, but I've also learned in the previous years how to have difficult conversations with compassion and tact. I don't mind speaking in front of groups of people, but I find one-on-one contact much richer as group dynamics are less at play and there's more room for deeper conversations.


